# Preface

Den Danske Stat TSP (Trust Service Provider) is issuing timestamps according to *Regulation (EU) 2024/1183 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 April 2024 amending Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 as regards establishing the European Digital Identity Framework* (hereafter denoted eIDAS2).

The TSP is operated by the Agency for Digital Government on behalf of the Danish State.

The qualified timestamps are issued in compliance with the European standards ETSI EN 319 401, ETSI EN 319 421 and ETSI EN 319 422.

This document constitutes the Time Stamp Authority (TSA) Disclosure Statement which is not an agreement but can be a part of an agreement between the TSP and parties requesting and relying on timestamps issued by TSA.

## Electronic time-stamp types and usage

The TSA issues qualified timestamps compliant with eIDAS2, ETSI EN 319 421 and ETSI EN 319 422.

Timestamps issued by TSA are general purpose timestamps following *Best practice Time-Stamp Policy (BTSP)* cf. ETSI EN 319 421.

Timestamps can be used where the accuracy of the timestamps is adequate for the purpose.

The TSA service issuing timestamps is available on a 24/7/365 basis but only through the Danish Agency for Digital Government's Signing service. The TSA cannot be held liable for the availability being provided.

## Reliance limits

The accuracy of timestamps is 500 milliseconds.

Logs and registration information are retained for at least seven years and can be used as evidence in legal disputes.

## Obligations of subscribers

N/A. Currently the Agency of Digital Government is the only subscriber of the service.

## TSU public key certificate status checking obligations of relying parties

Before relying on a timestamp, a relying party must verify that the timestamp is signed correctly with a valid Timestamping Unit (TSU) certificate from Den Danske Stat TSA present in the EU trusted list.

Furthermore, the relying party shall verify the timestamp and the TSU certificate for any limitations on usage. This includes that the accuracy of the timestamp is adequate for the purpose.



# Limited warranty and disclaimer/Limitation of liability

The TSP is liable to anyone who reasonably relies on a valid timestamp according to the general rules of Danish law, unless the TSP can lift the burden of proof for not having acted intentionally or negligently, including that the timestamp has not been issued in accordance eIDAS2.

Losses due to TSP's errors in connection with issuance of the timestamp are covered by TSP's responsibility.
